## **EGM MINUTES 24<sup>th</sup> MAY 2011**

- 1. Apologies: None received.**
- 2. Fixture list 2011 -2012**

The proposed county fixture list was discussed, and organisers and venues allocated to each competition. The venue for the senior county foil, U/16/18 FES, 4 weapon team, and senior epee/sabre will be at Benenden school depending on PH confirming with John Chorley. The junior foil competition is proposed to be held at Eltham College.

PH suggested that the senior individual entry fee should be raised from £14 to £15. All present agreed.

The team entry fees and school entry fees are to remain the same as last year. No date for AGM was set at the meeting.

CK to produce list of recent recipients of county colours to put on Kent website.

CK also reported that the county team had recently taken part in the Excalibur Tournament in Bath where they had finished 4<sup>th</sup>, the best result for the county Team for many years. Peter Barwell won the individual mens foil.

Several new young fencers took part, looking good for the future.

Photos of the event are now on the county website and a report to follow from CK County teams also fenced in the Miller Hallet epee team event before Christmas and it is hoped to make this a regular event for the county team.

**PH reported that the county had received a grant of £750 from KCC and it was agreed that this should be used to buy a set of plastic fencing kit for the county.**
